Welcome back! I hope you all had a restful Thanksgiving vacation. It will be very busy around here these next few weeks as we head toward winter break.

Parents are very important members of our school community. **Parent representatives serve on several district and site committees** including the English Language Advisory Committee (ELAC) and School Site Council (SSC). Now is a good time to discuss your family's plan should there be an earthquake or other disaster during school hours. Page 135 in the school directory/handbook provides information about emergency planning for parents. I encourage your to read this and keep the information handy. Finally, be sure that the names and phone numbers on your child's emergency card are current. You can update this information via InfoSnap at any time. This is the information we use to release your child during an emergency.

It's hard to believe, but we are gearing up for next year's **kindergarten registration!** Tours will begin in December and registration on January 28, 2013. Please be sure to read the details about the kindergarten registration and session request process in the article below. If you know of any families with incoming kindergarteners, please be sure to share the information with them.

This process is different than for those entering kindergarten or for new students.
